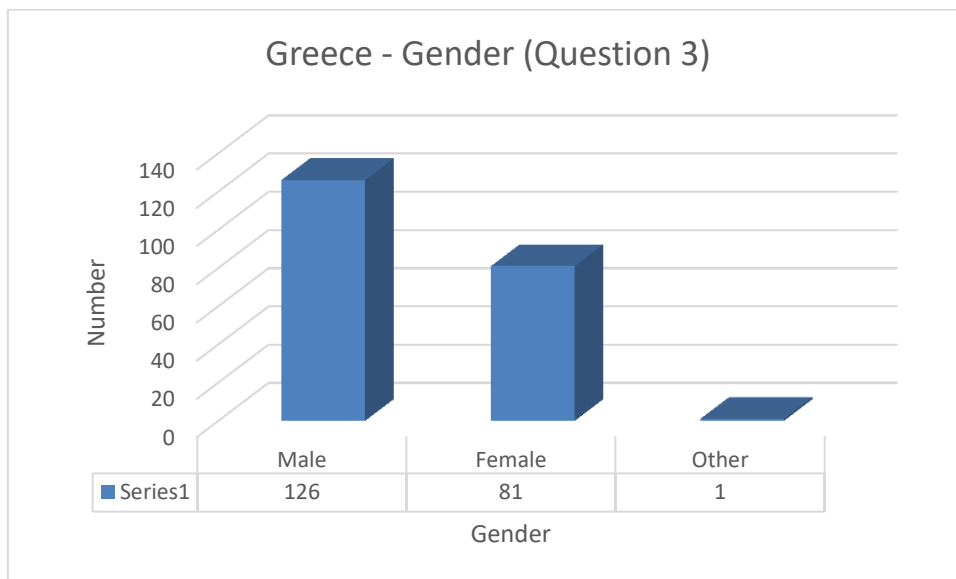


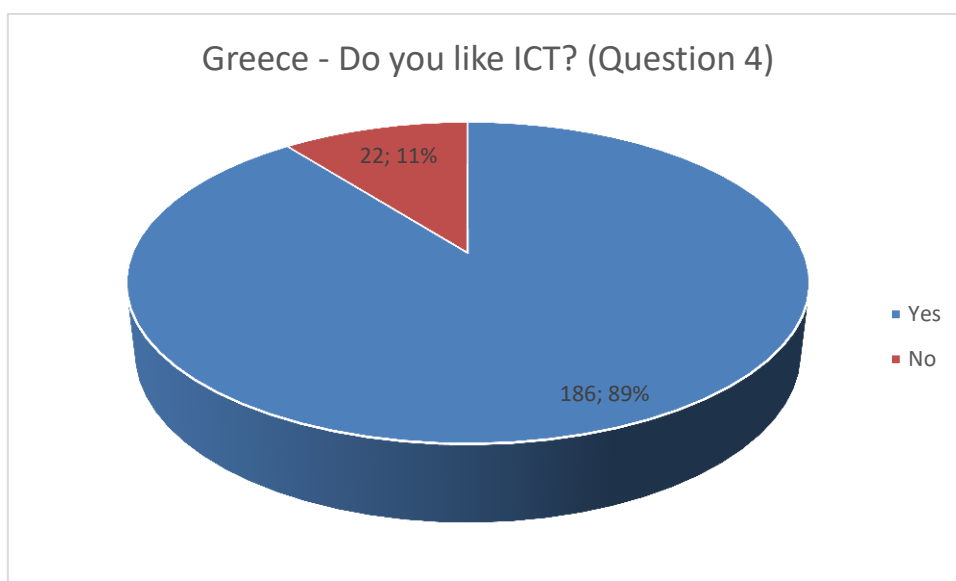
Statistics on ICT Survey

Greek Students – 2nd Vocational School of Katerini

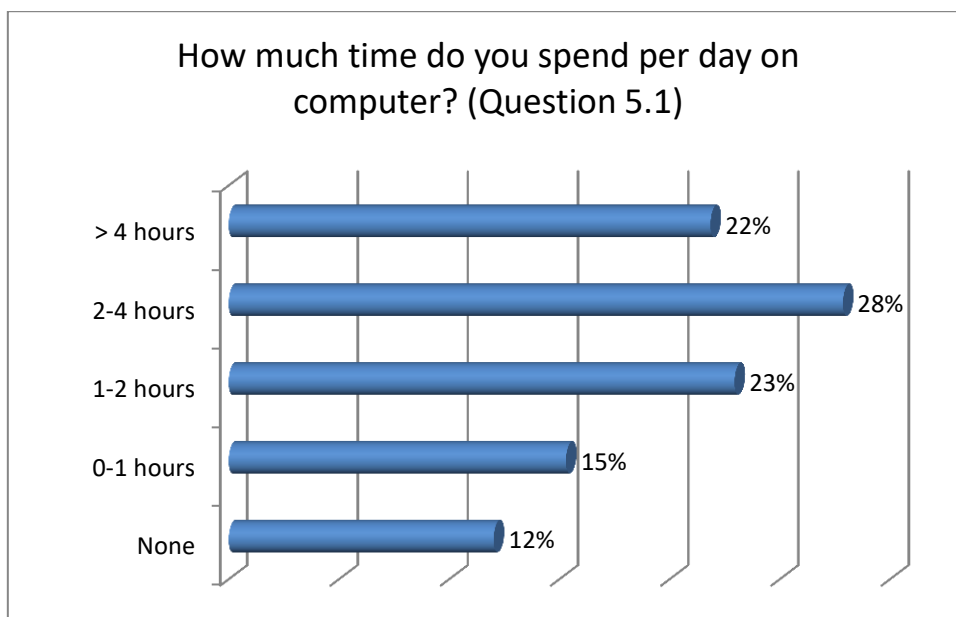
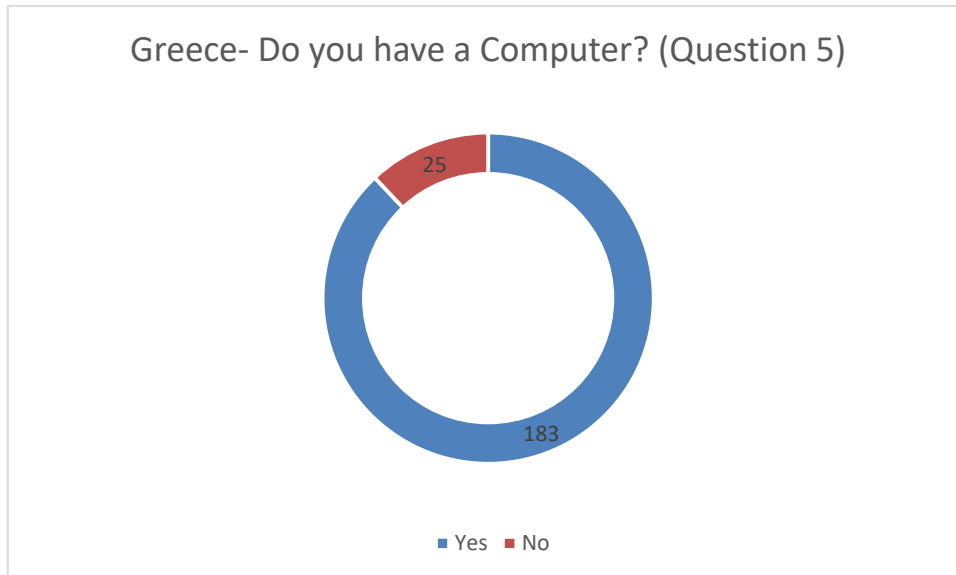
In November 2018 a survey with a questionnaire in a random sample of students was held at 2nd Vocational School of Katerini, concerning mainly ICT Knowledge. In the survey participated 208 students, which corresponds to around 40% of the total school students. The students participated in the questionnaire study at IT sector, Economics sector, Agriculture sector and Health Science sector. More specifically in the survey participated 126 (61%) male students, 81 female (38,5%) students and 1 (0,5%) student that responded as a gender “other”.



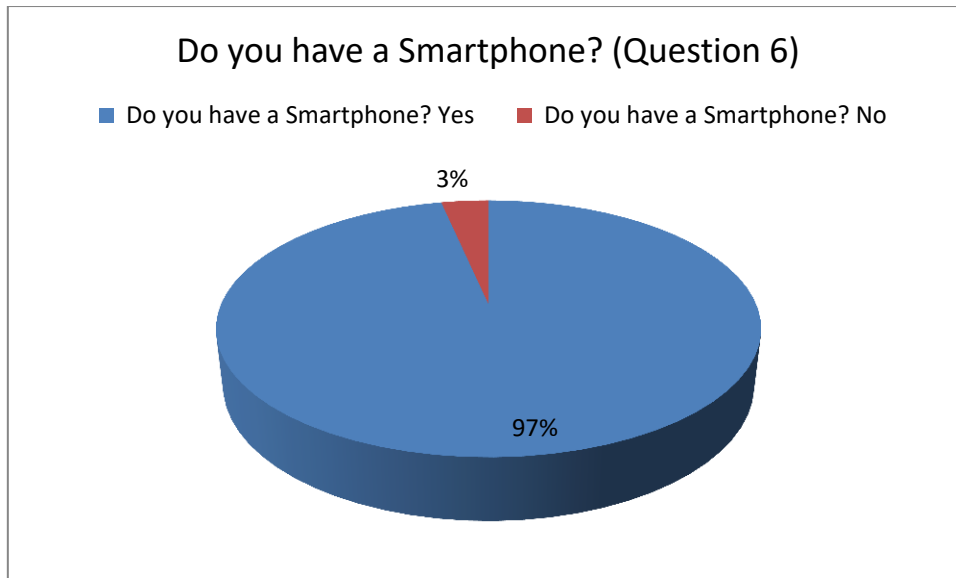
It is very interesting that the majority of the students (89%) replied that they like ICT and only 11% replied that they don't like ICT (see image below)



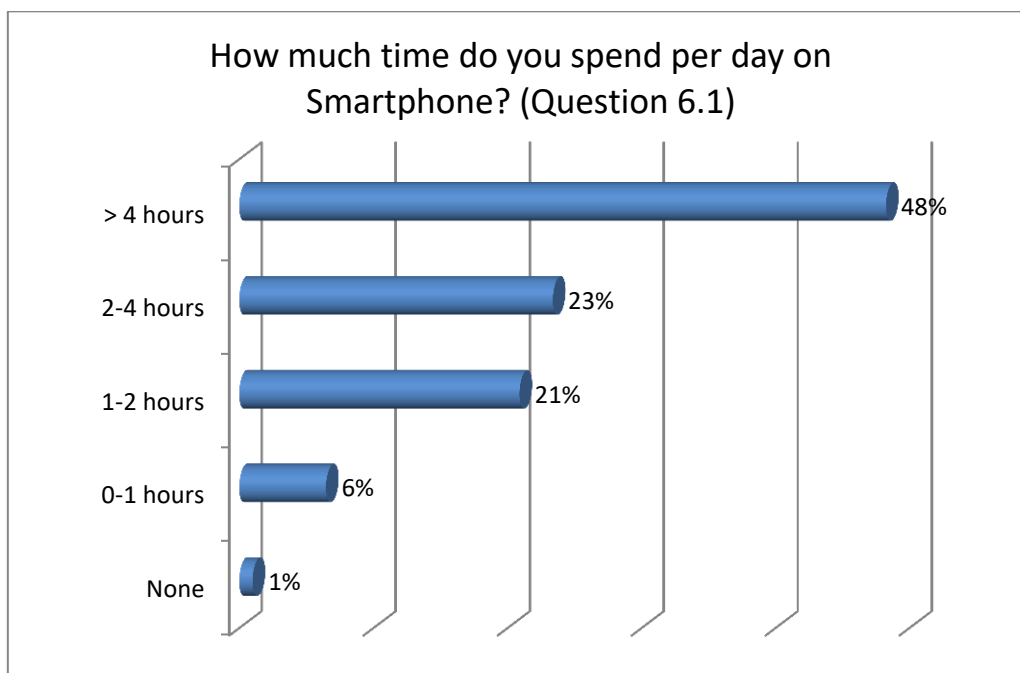
New technologies and computers have penetrated dramatically into pupils' lives and the proof is that most students have a computer at home, a mobile phone, and other technology devices and devote several hours of their day to use them. As you can see below 183, that is 88% out of 208 have a computer at home. Moreover, 28% of them, use the computer for 2-4 hours daily, while only 15% uses it less than one hour.



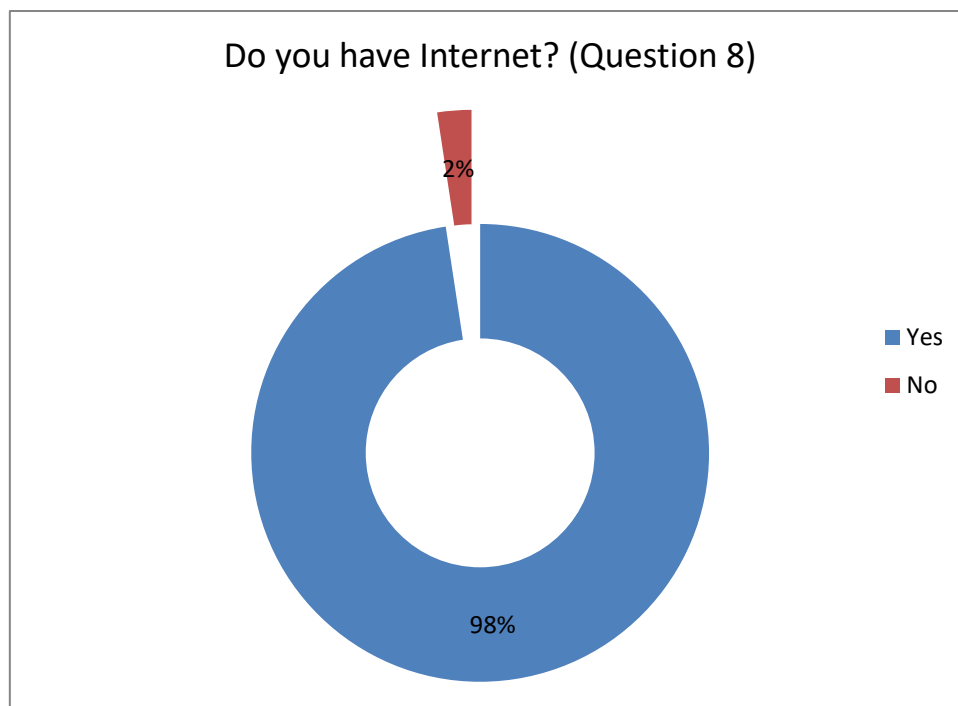
It is really very impressive the fact that almost all the students (97%), responded that they have and use a smartphone.



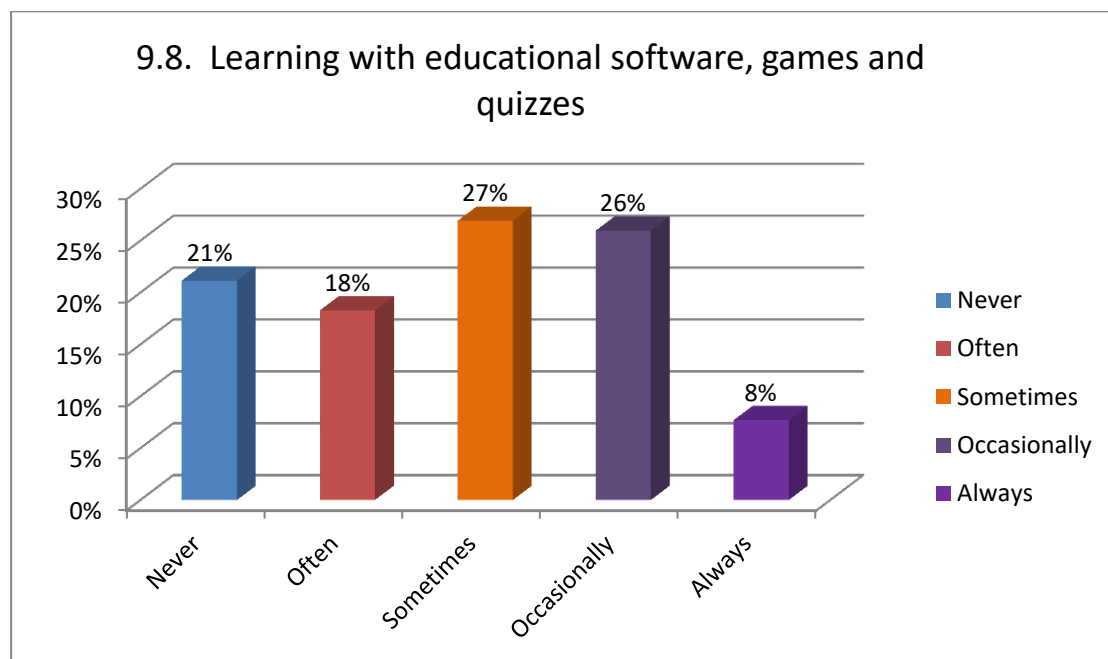
It is more impressive that 48% of the students said that they use daily their smartphone more than 4 hours. We really wonder what they are doing more than 4 hours daily with their mobile phone.



As you can see below 98% of the students in 2nd Vocational School of Katerini said that they have internet at home. Moreover looking at the data, we can see that students spend many hours on the internet daily.

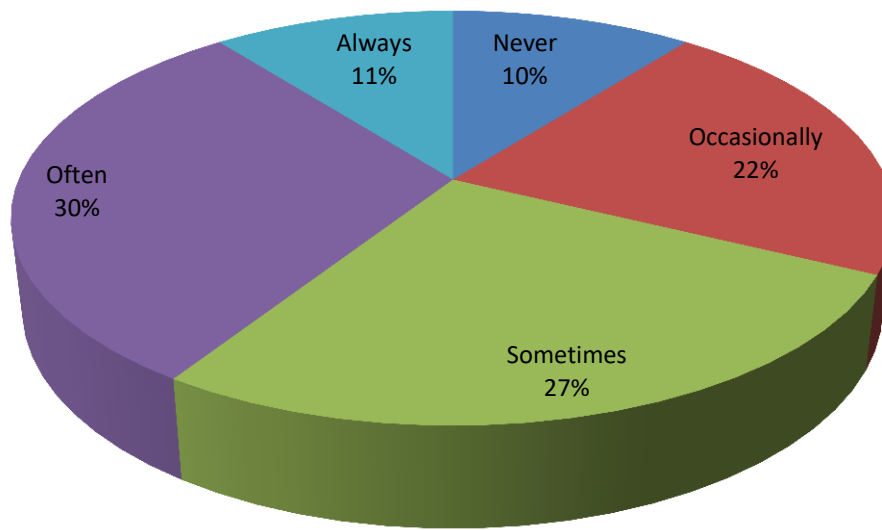


About 53% of the students of our school say that sometimes or occasionally use educational software, games or quizzes to learn and only 8% of the students always use the above tools for the learning process.



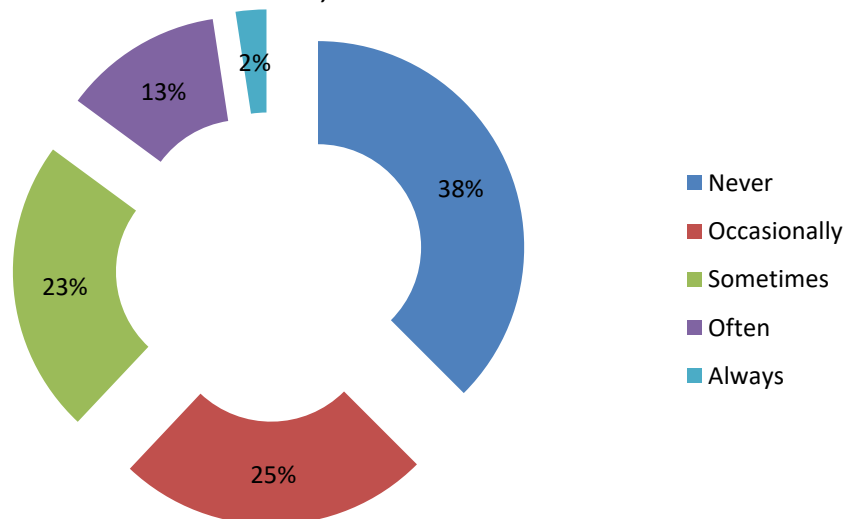
Almost half of the students, search the internet for school work and only 10% never looks at the internet for information concerning school work (question 10.2)

10.2. Search the Internet for information for school work

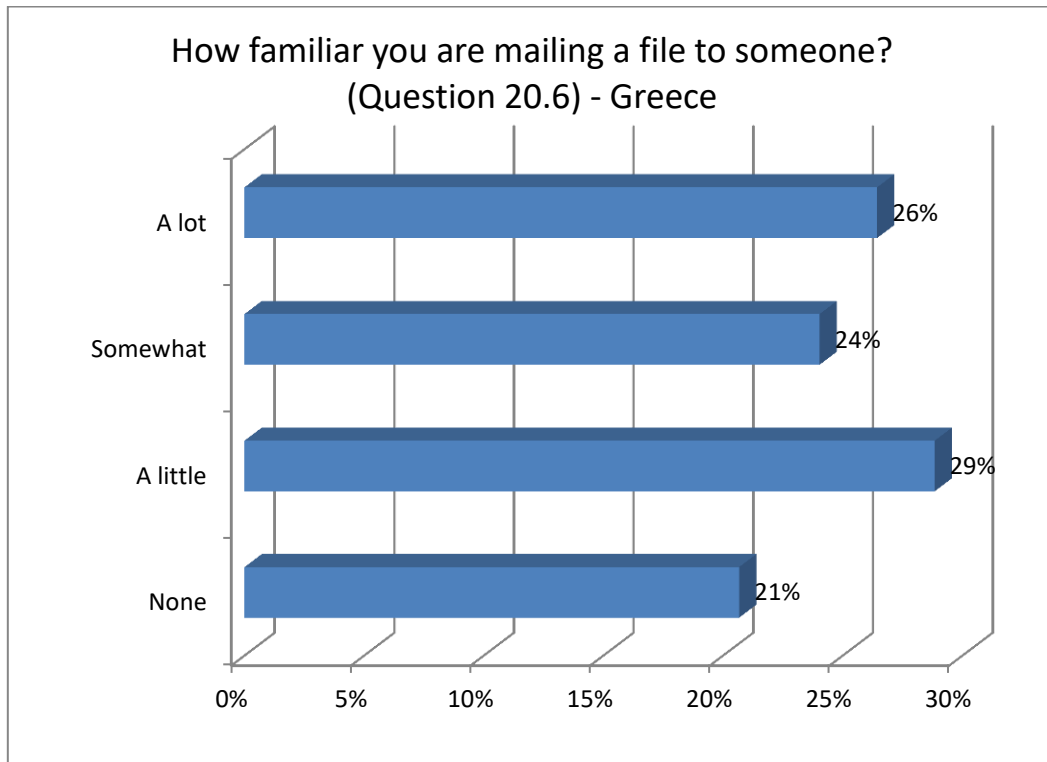


The majority of the students (38%) never check the school website for announcements, etc, while only 2% always check the website. Probably we should change something at our website or the way we use it.

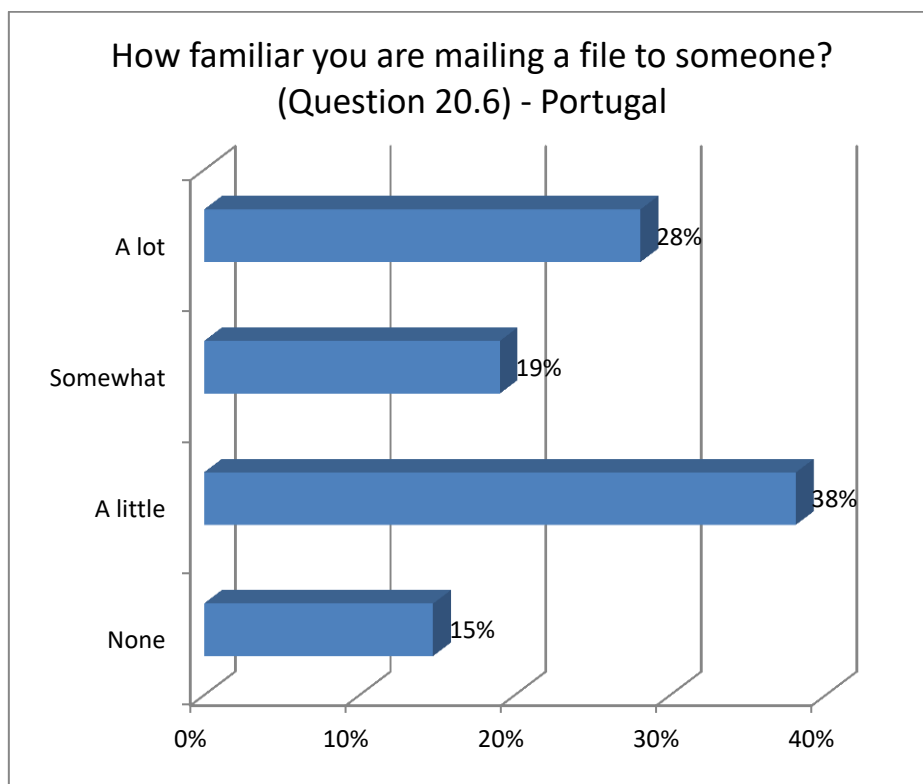
10.14. Check the school website for announcements, dates, etc.



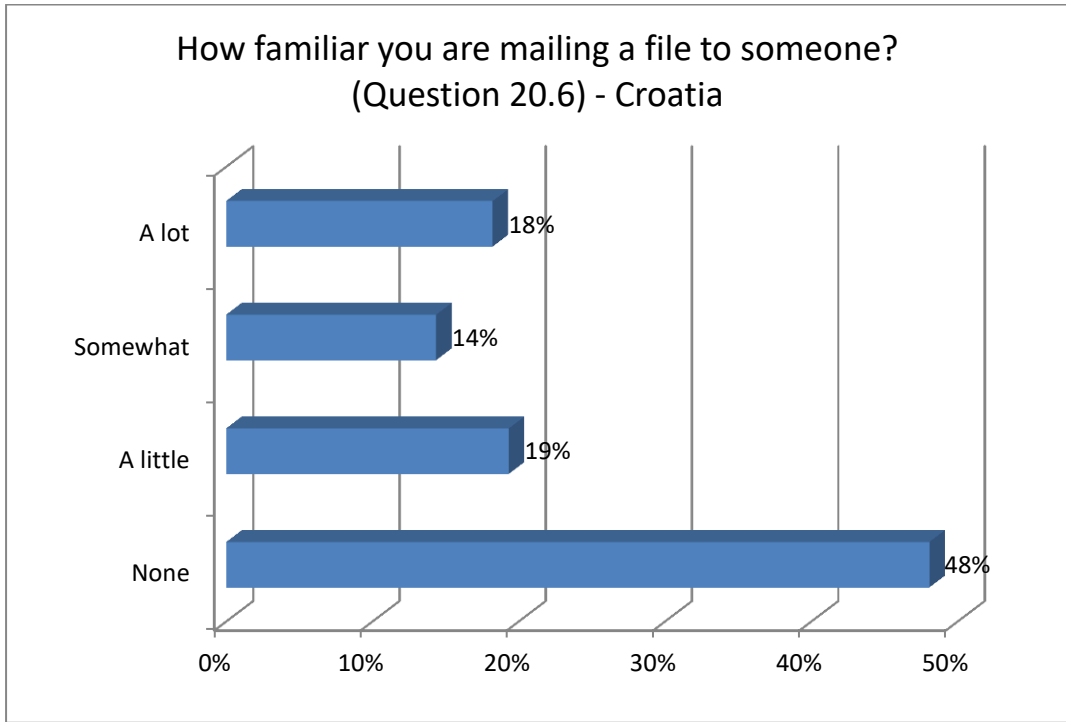
It is quite important and valuable to see what is the level of ICT knowledge of the students and how they spend their time using ICT. Looking at the following graph, we can see that only 26% of the students know for sure how to attach actually a file to an email. Fifty percent (50%) of the student have no idea or they have a small knowledge sending a file via an email.



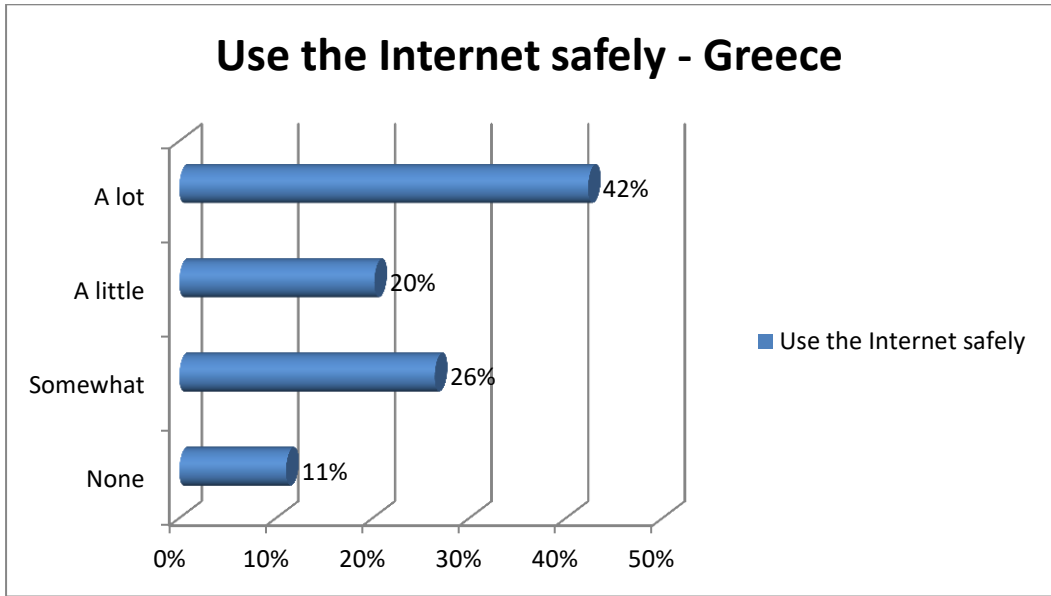
Comparing the above results with the other countries participated in the questionnaire, we can come to the conclusion that the results are almost the same in Greece, Portugal and Sweden. At least 50% of students of the above countries are somewhat or a lot familiar sending an email with an attached file.



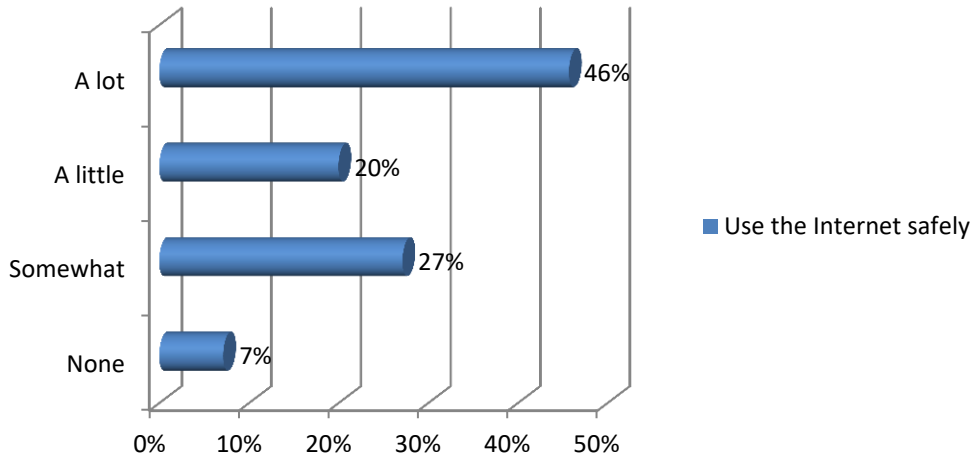
However looking at the same question at the other three countries we notice that more than 50% of the students said that they have no idea or little knowledge about send an email with a file attached. The impressive at this question is that almost 50% of students from Croatia said that they have no idea about sending an email with a file.



Comparing “How safe the students believe that they use internet” between Greece, Portugal and Croatia, we notice that Greece and Portugal have almost the same results. Around 45% believe that they use internet safely a lot, however in Croatia only 28% of the students respond that they use the internet safely a lot. Moreover 23% of the students in Croatia believe that they don’t use the internet safely at all.
